

Prerequisite for application to SAFA MIE Group to be considered

A candidate must:

Practical Qualification

- a) Be registered as an Installation Electrician for two years.
- b) **Provide 5 years proven relevant workplace experience**, in hazardous locations (letter from employers or certificate of service from employer).
- c) Submit documentary proof of successful completed unit standards on inspection, testing and certification of specialized electrical installations in hazardous locations as prescribed by the EWSETA
- d) Submit documentary proof of the RPL declaration from South African Flameproof Association (SAFA) MIE Group.

Minimum Theoretical Qualification

- a) National N3 Certificate with the following compulsory subjects:

- Mathematics
- Engineering science or industrial electronics
- Electrical trade theory or electro-technology

Or

- b) Grade 12 (Standard 10) Certificate

- Mathematics
- Science
- Technica – electrical or an equivalent subject that may include a N3 subject

Note 1: The candidate must pass each subject with a minimum of 40%.

Note 2 : These minimum theoretical subjects could be a combination of Grade 12 and N3 subjects.

Knowledge of Statutory Requirements

Proof of knowledge on the legislation and relevant health and safety standards applicable to electrical installations by having passed the subject Specialised Codes as administered by the Department of Higher Education and Training.

NOTE: - If your application does not meet the minimum requirements as set out above it will be rejected and your application fee forfeited
